Saturday, July 23, 2011 2-5 PM Class Time

***Flower Garden Basket with Jan Featherstone...\$20--**This basket comes in a variety of colors all happy and bright. Jan says it would make an ideal wine basket among other uses. It has a nice tall handle as well. Come to Jan's class and enjoy creating again and take home a homemade treasure from camp. She says no supplies are needed for this class.

***Padded Hanger Covers with Linda Parkinson...\$10--**Cure all your "hang-ups"! Learn to make cute padded hanger covers. Linda says there're great for anything you don't want to get "pokie shoulders" in. Makes wonderful gifts for family, friends, teachers, etc. You will have time to make several. Extra hangers will be available for those taking the class. Linda is asking you to bring your basic sewing kit and sewing machine along with 2 coordinating fat quarters or 1/3 yard of 2 coordinating fabrics, scrap batting (not fluffy)- 2 pieces about 10x20.

***Calendar of Cards with Teresa Stokes and Sara Smith...\$15--**Be proud to send off these cards that you hand make yourself. The girls will teach you how to make one special card dedicated to each month of the year. Embelishments galore are included in your creations. Leave with 12 cards beautifully done. You need bring nothing to this class except scissors.

***Snowman Ornament with Beverly Tomasello...\$8--**Take a quiet afternoon to stitch this felt ornament into a Christmas treasure. Bev will show you how to do a buttonhole stitch around the face of this darling little guy. He will be stuffed and dressed with a fancy bow at his neck, snappy button eyes and much more by the time you leave Bev's class. She asks you to bring a pair of scissors to this class.

***Make and Take with Kate Schmitgall...\$varies--**Again Kate will offer up her plethora of wonderful make and take items for you to work on all through your camp days at your leisure. Come and see what she has in her treasure chest of goodies.

***Sparkling Crystal Bracelet with Kate Schloz...\$12--**Bling is the order of the afternoon when you take this class with Kate where you will create this sparkling wonder of a bracelet. You will use a wire wrapping technique of jewelry design for this cuff type bracelet with crystals. Beginners are very welcome and will be successful. Bring jewelry tools if you have them and any beads from home that you might like to incorporate in this piece, however, Kate will have all you need for your bracelet. Kate will also offer this class on Sunday afternoon for those who cannot make this class.

***Wild Wacky Woman Cell or Money Tote with Alice Hunt...\$3--**Make this cute necklace to carry things at camp or home. Add your name and it becomes your name tag! Alice says there is an assortment of fabrics for clothes and colors of hair. You choose what you like. Please bring your sewing machine and a basic sewing kit to Alice's class and prepare to have fun!

***Stunning Beaded Sun Catcher with Michelle Norton...\$12.50--**Michelle will show you how to take a clear glass disk and turn it into stunning sun catcher with the application of beads. It can be made as a flower or a string of them can be placed together for a beautiful affect. Michelle, an experienced beader, says you will have a grand time in her class and says you need to bring nothing to her offering.

Sunday, July 24, 2011 9:30-11-30 AM Class Time

***Painted Glasses and Votives with Jo Menacher...\$2 per piece--**Get ready to have so much fun with Jo when she shows you how to take plain glassware that you bring into marvelous enamel painted works of art! Run to the dollar store and pick out some pieces to bring to paint. Jo will show you paint strokes that will make that glassware glow! Bring as many pieces as you like and make a matched set. Consider vases, votives and glassware of any kind. Jo asks you to bring a basic painting kit as well as paper towels and a hair dryer. She says you will smile with every minute in class!

***Crystal flower Pendant with Necklace with Michelle Norton...\$15--**Get set for a night out wearing this beautiful pendant made of hearts which are transformed into a floral design. The crystals are so bright and beautiful. The necklace is seed beaded to complete the look. Michelle says she will help you finish your project and you will be proud to wear it. You need bring nothing to this class, but expect to leave with a "jewel".

***Susie Sunshine Basket - Part 1 of 2 - with Jan Featherstone...\$20--**Sunshine never looked so good as Jan's offering of this darling basket surrounded with bright sunflowers. You can't help but be happy in looking at it and imagine how happy you will be to make it! There are so many uses for this basket says Jan. All you need for this class Jan will provide. Note: Part 2 of this class is Monday afternoon.

***Tied Basket with Alice Hunt...\$5--**Alice will help you make this super simple quilted basket that you can use for a centerpiece for your table for any season. Consider it too for candy or even to hold a gift. It will untie to conveniently fold flat. Several seasonal fabrics will be available for your choice. Alice says you can make one or several. You will need to bring a basic sewing kit and sewing machine, though Alice says that if you have no machine, one can be provided for your use.

***Twinkle Quilt with Becky Billman...\$10--**The uses for this quilt number many: a wall hanging, a baby quilt or a table topper. You will master making the half square triangle (HST) unit in the blocks for this quilt with a simple, quick, easy method. Each of the 9 blocks is completely made up of the half square triangle unit. Becky says that the quilt looks good when you use light/medium, medium/medium dark prints of the same colorway with a light background fabric. Come stitch with Becky and learn this grand quilt project. Please bring sewing machine, a basic sewing kit, 1 piece each of 9 different prints in chosen colorway, 1 ¼ yd background fabric (light/white on white/cream, etc); 2 ¾ backing fabric, 3/8 yd for binding, 60x60 batting.

***“Felted Fannie” Pin with Bonnie Smith...\$8--**“Eclectic” is the word for this inventive piece that Bonnie brings to you. Each piece will start with felted sweater fabric and a molded face that Bonnie has hand painted. There are scores of faces and several fabrics from which to choose. Add silvertone hands and high heels along with a multitude of beads and you have a unique and interesting piece of wearable art. Please bring scissors to this class and come create!

Sunday, July 24, 2-5:00 PM Class Time

***Tidy-Tote with Beth Braun...\$12--**This unique class will be a life saver for all you sewers who get so frustrated with threads and scraps while you are stitching. Beth has a valuable item for your sewing machine in this Tidy Tote which will both serve as a pin cushion and also a scrap bin for your threads and fabric. Beth says her kits will provide all you need but asks you to bring thread in neutral colors along with your basic sewing kit and a machine in good working order. By Sunday night you will be prepared to have a stress less time sewing on Monday with your new Tidy Tote.

***Windmill Revisited with Kate Schmitgall...\$40--**It is a grand technique Kate is going to share with you in this project. You will strip piece and then cut the fabric into pinwheels using 18 different green fabrics...for March or spring or seasons. Kate is sure you will absolutely love this new technique! Please bring your basic sewing kit with your machine and rotary cutting equipment. You will also need a 9 ½” square ruler or “Strip Tube Ruler” for this class.

***Dresden Plate Candle or Table Mat with Alice Hunt...\$10--**Alice has chosen this lovely version of the Dresden plate block to teach you. You can choose any initial to place in the center of your work to personalize it. Alice says you can make this on the sewing machine or choose to stitch by hand. She will have all the supplies you need to take home a lovely piece. However, you will need to bring your basic sewing kit.

***Sparkling Crystal Bracelet with Kate Schloz...\$12--**Everyone needs a little bling and you will get it with this cuff bracelet that Kate will help you make. Beginners are going to be very successful with this wire wrap method, says Kate. You be the designer of your original piece. Bring extra beads from home if you like and jewelry tools if you have them. Be prepared to stun everyone with your “Sparkle”.

***Wild Foam Flowers with Lura Ludolph...\$2--**Get Crazy! Design away! Create these darling foam flowers to put on your flip flops or hair barrettes or even your name tag! You will complete 3 foam flowers that include a brad in the center for application to the flip flops, hair designs or name tag. Bring flip flops of any color or plan to use these Wild Things on something at home. Lura asks you to bring a snail adhesive tape runner or glue dots to this class.

***Susie Sunshine Basket - Part 2 - with Jan Featherstone...** By now you are well on your way to completing your fantastic floral basket with Jan that you started in the morning. Sunflowers are sure to be surrounding you as you continue to work your way to your completed basket. Part 1 of this class was begun with the Sunday morning class.

***Painted Santa Face on Gift Bag with Jo Menacher...\$5--**Christmas will take on a whole new meaning with this adorable paper gift bag Jo will help you paint. Use your original designer bag to hold a special gift or perhaps some delicious offerings from your kitchen and take pride in your artistry. Maybe Santa will begin to shout out "HO HO HO" as you complete your work. Bring your basic painting kit, paper towels, and a hair dryer to this class and come have Christmas fun in July!

Sunday, July 24, 2011 7:30 PM-9:00 Class Time

***Flower Pot Snowman with Kate Schmitgall...\$3-5--**Choose a 4" or 6" pot to paint into a snowman that will melt your heart. The class is easy and peaceful and so fun to do. Kate will have all the supplies you need to make this chilly fellow.

***Coral Fringe Pendant with Michelle Norton...\$10--**Make a lush pendant with a fringe technique that Michelle will teach you. The student can work to make the pendant a size comfortable for them. Michelle will bring with her all the supplies necessary for this project.

***Old World Santa Sweatshirt with Bonnie Smith...\$8--**Using jewel tones, come and paint this old world Santa and be ready for the busy Christmas season way ahead of time. Choose a soft rose, a burgundy or maybe a crisp green for his flowing robe. The fur on his garment and his hair will seem to lift off the fabric. Add a few rhinestones to his surroundings and you have a lovely representation of the holidays. Bring a white sweatshirt, plastic covered shirt board and masking tape to this class along with your basic painting kit and paper towels and a pencil.

***Fabric Luggage Tags with Beth Braun...\$5--**These bright fabric luggage tags will allow you to identify your bags quickly from a distance when traveling. They are wonderful to use for tote bags, sewing machines, and any other traveling items that need to be tagged. They are easy to make. Visiting friends coming? Make these tags and mail them in advance to your guests. Beth says these make wonderful gifts as well. Your kit will make 2 luggage tags. Please bring neutral thread and a sewing machine in good working order.

Monday, July 25, 2011 8:30-11:30 Class Time

***"Be Sweet" Play Quilt - Part 1 of 2 - with Linda Parkinson...\$20--**Easy to make blocks complete this darling play quilt 40" square or sweet cuddle quilt 45 X 54. No waste, no trimming. You can use 2 charm packs or cut your own 5" charm squares. Add a background fabric and, TADA...you have BE SWEET! Both quilts will require additional fabric and batting. Linda asks that you call (evenings) or email her for cutting and shopping pictures and information. Quilting instructions will be included as time allows. Bring with you a basic sewing kit, a machine with a walking foot...VERY IMPORTANT...and other basic quilting supplies of rulers, rotary cutter, mat, pins, etc. Optional; disappearing fabric marker. When you get home, what a lovely "cuddle" you will have with this "Sweet" project. Note: Part 2 of this class is Monday afternoon.

***Craft (or Whatnot) Apron with Kate Schmitgall...\$12--**Here is a project you can truly use at camp...and apron with multiple pockets for every use imaginable! Think supplies or projects, or even phones! You personalize this apron with pockets appropriate for your needs. Four different colors of denim to choose from for the base and then "sewing fabrics" available for your pockets. Cute as can be and so useful. Kate asks you to bring your sewing machine and a basic sewing kit to her class.

***Tulip Time Basket with Jan Featherstone...\$20--**A Tisket, a tasket, you'll make a square basket! Come to this class and make your basket and then adorn it with tulips galore. This 10 X 10" basket has more uses than you can imagine. Jan will give you all the knowledge and supplies you need to be successful in her class. Now on to "a tisket, a tasket"!

***Midnight Mustangs Sweatshirt with Bonnie Smith...\$8--**Galloping along a ridge is this string of wild horses, complete with a colt, painted on a black sweatshirt. A bright moon shines in the night sky illuminating flashing hooves and flying manes with just a touch of gold. A few "diamonds stars" sparkle in the dark above the horses' heads. Bonnie says that everyone taking the class will go home with a shirt they are proud of...even if you have never painted before. Please bring a black sweatshirt, shirt board and masking tape, basic painting kit and paper towels to this class.

***Halloween Screen Painting with Jo Menacher...\$10--**Spooks or maybe pumpkins are what you choose to be painted on this screening and then framed to use for your holiday. Or take the 'spook' out and paint a birdhouse instead for year round use. Jo will teach you this incredible artistry and you will enjoy the process and product. Truly a unique technique and such fun to create. Please bring your basic painting kit, paper towels, and a hair dryer to this class.

***Picture Tote Bag with Alice Hunt...\$15--**Make this large lined tote bag with one side divided into windows to add your favorite photos and the back quilted with a religious print cut out (several choices). Brown, green and pink fabrics are provided to make the bag. Make as shown or divide photo area into your personal needs. Absolutely great for showing off those grandkids or your creative quilt photos! Alice says you need only your machine and a basic sewing kit for her class.

***Spa Kit with Faye Krause...\$12--**Time to relax after your busy camp days with this spa class Faye is offering. You will make wonderfully scented bath salts and 2-3 bars of soap. Just imagine how delighted you will be to soothe your soul with your creativity from this class. Faye asks you to bring scissors to her class.

Monday, July 25, 2011 2:00-5:00 PM Class Time

***Cup Cake Oven Mitts with Mary Schroba...\$7**--Cooking in your kitchen will seem like party time with these uniquely designed oven mitts. Use them yourself or present them as a gift to a friend. Mary will teach you how to create these cute mitts and have you ready to use them at home. Please bring 1 fat quarter of cotton fabric for the base and 1 fat quarter for the cup cake top. You will also need matching threads and ¼ yard of COTTON batting . Bring your sewing machine and a basic sewing kit.

***Cha Cha Bracelet with Michelle Norton...\$15-\$10**--Dangles galore adorn this wire and crystal bracelet. Glitter and shine will flash from your wrist with this project. You can choose to use Swarovski crystals or glass crystals in your creation. Take some time to create something just for you in this class with Michelle. All supplies are included in the cost of this class.

***Wonder Wallet with Beth Braun...\$5**--What an easy fun project this will be for you. Beth will help you make this small purse which will hold your important items like your driver's license, credit cards, cash and more. This is a quick project and could be used for a super homemade gift for a friend. Your kit will contain all you need to be successful but please bring your sewing machine in good condition and some neutral thread.

***Snappy Bags with Kate Schmitgall...\$5**--Machine quilting will finish this little purse that Kate will help you make. The opening on the bag will snap shut! Various fabrics and sizes will be offered for this creation. Bring your sewing machine, a walking foot for quilting and your basic sewing kit to this class and leave with a new purse!

***"Be Sweet" - Part 2 - with Linda Parkinson...**You will continue your sewing on this quilt as started in the Monday morning session. Linda will help you make this cute cuddly quilt. Check the Monday morning classes to find what you need to bring to this class.

***Lonely Petunia Basket with Jan Featherstone...\$20**--The lovely petunia may be lonely, but what a great statement this basket makes. This basket is especially fresh and bright and you will enjoy the process of making it with Jan. This basket is handles for a unique and different look. No supplies are needed for this project.

Tuesday, July 26, 2011 8:30-11:30 AM Class Time

***Memory Keeper Album with Teresa Stokes...\$10**--We all have those photos that need a home and Teresa has just the answer in this 6" square album which has 10 pages. Perhaps scrapbooking is your interest; this album can be used for that too. Teresa has a number of embellishments to compliment your work. Photo corners will be included in this project. Come and see how Teresa can help you make this perfect memory keeper. Take a few extra photos at camp this year to tuck inside your new album! Please bring glue or tape. Journal pens and photos are optional.

***Bugle Beaded Ring with Joyce Parish...\$6.50**--Bugle beads circle the outside of this ring and then a set on top completes the project. Joyce will be sure you walk away wearing this ring, sized correctly, at the end of the class. No supplies are needed to take this offering. Just come and bead away!

***Crystal Flower Pendant and Necklace with Michelle Norton...\$15**--Michelle is giving you one more chance to experience beading in this pendant made of Swarovski heart crystals which when sewn together make a heart. A seed bead necklace finishes off this stunning piece. Come and enjoy this creative class and wear your necklace home. Michelle will provide all materials you need for her class.
